TEACHING

University of California, Davis

My teaching at UC Davis spans the Master of Science in Business Analytics (MSBA), MBA, and Online MBA programs.

Machine Learning & Artificial Intelligence

MSBA, BAX-452. Students implement and evaluate methods in Python, from regression, classification, clustering, and trees to neural networks, natural language processing, large language models, and introductory reinforcement learning. The course emphasizes model selection, overfitting, and interpretability, culminating in an applied business project.

Data Design & Representation

MSBA, BAX-422. Students extract and process unstructured data using regular expressions, web scraping, JSON, and MongoDB. A final project integrates multiple sources into a coherent dataset or database and explains how the design supports a specific business problem.

AI and Business Innovation: A Journey from Linear Regression to Large Language Models

MBA, MGV-490A. This course introduces analytics and AI from a strategic business perspective, with introductory Python for students without programming experience. Topics range from regression and treatment effects to neural networks and large language models. An applied group project emphasizes interpreting results to inform business decisions.

Agentic AI: From Models to Systems

MBA, MGV-490B. Students will build agentic AI systems from scratch, using a multi-agent trading system as the in-class example. Topics include agent coordination, automated news analysis, and trading-platform integration through the Model Context Protocol (MCP).

Data Wrangling

MBA, MGT/B 435. Students use Python, web scraping, and regular expressions to automate data collection, processing, and aggregation. A final project combines multiple sources into a dataset for a business problem, explaining how the data and design choices support decisions.

Business of the Future

Wine Executive Program, University of California, Davis. Wine-industry executives examine how artificial intelligence and data analysis can inform business decisions, with applications to profitability and customer retention.
